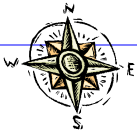


Directions:

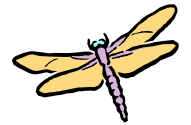


The Insectarium is conveniently located in Northeast Philadelphia.

- From I-95 take the Cottman Avenue exit, continue on Cottman Avenue to Frankford Avenue and make a right, follow to 8046 Frankford Ave.
- From the Pennsylvania Turnpike, take exit 28 to Route 1 south, stay in center lanes and take Rhawn St. exit, make a left onto Rhawn St. and follow to Frankford Ave., make a left and follow to 8046 Frankford Ave.
- From Roosevelt Blvd. (Rte.1) turn east onto Rhawn St. and follow to Frankford Ave and make a left, look for 8046 Frankford Ave.

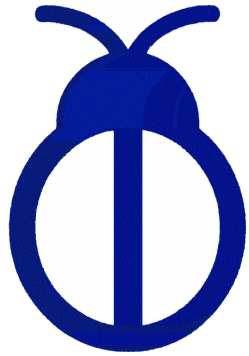

Travel Show Program

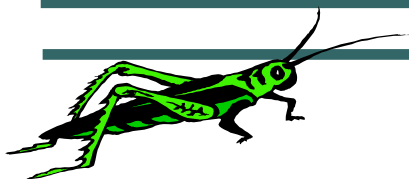
